Federal Funding for Building and Energy Codes

Why?

- Increased frequency and severity of hazard events
- household energy bills growing
- nation looking to reduce energy related emissions

U.S. federal grant programs are now available to assist state, local, tribal, and territorial (SLTT) governments in implementing solutions. Many of these grants are either *exclusively or significantly designated for building code related activities.*

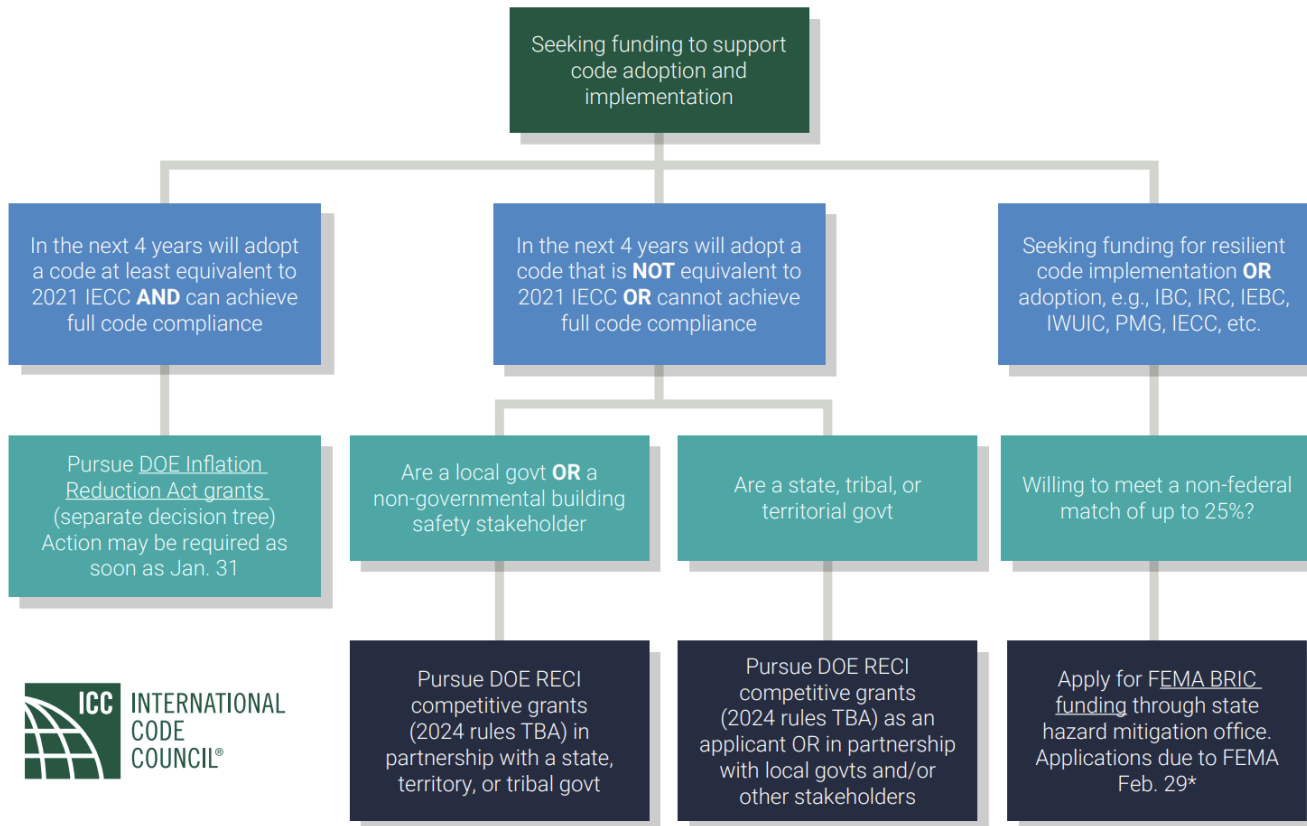
What We Do:

- we have established relationships with other industry leaders

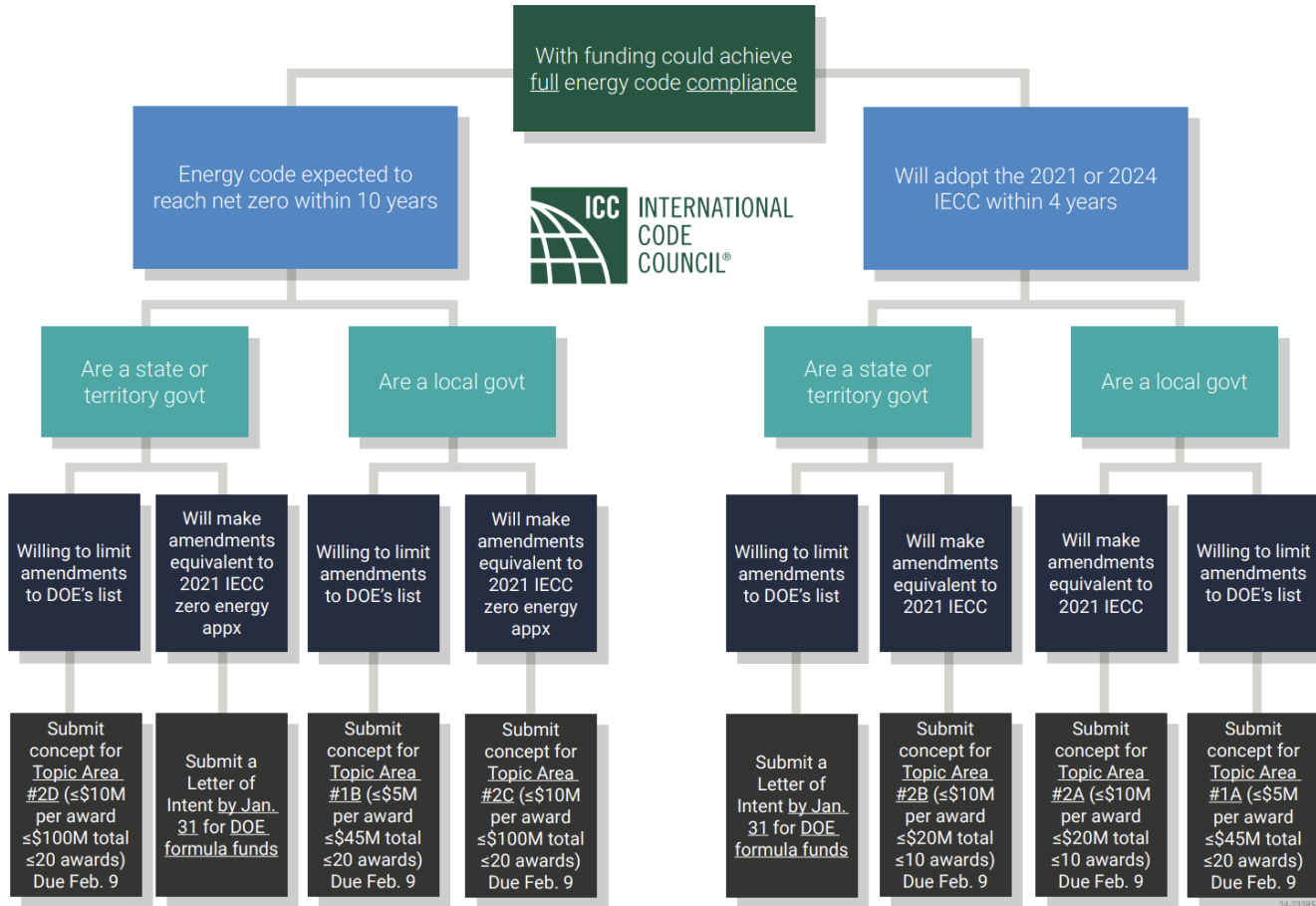
